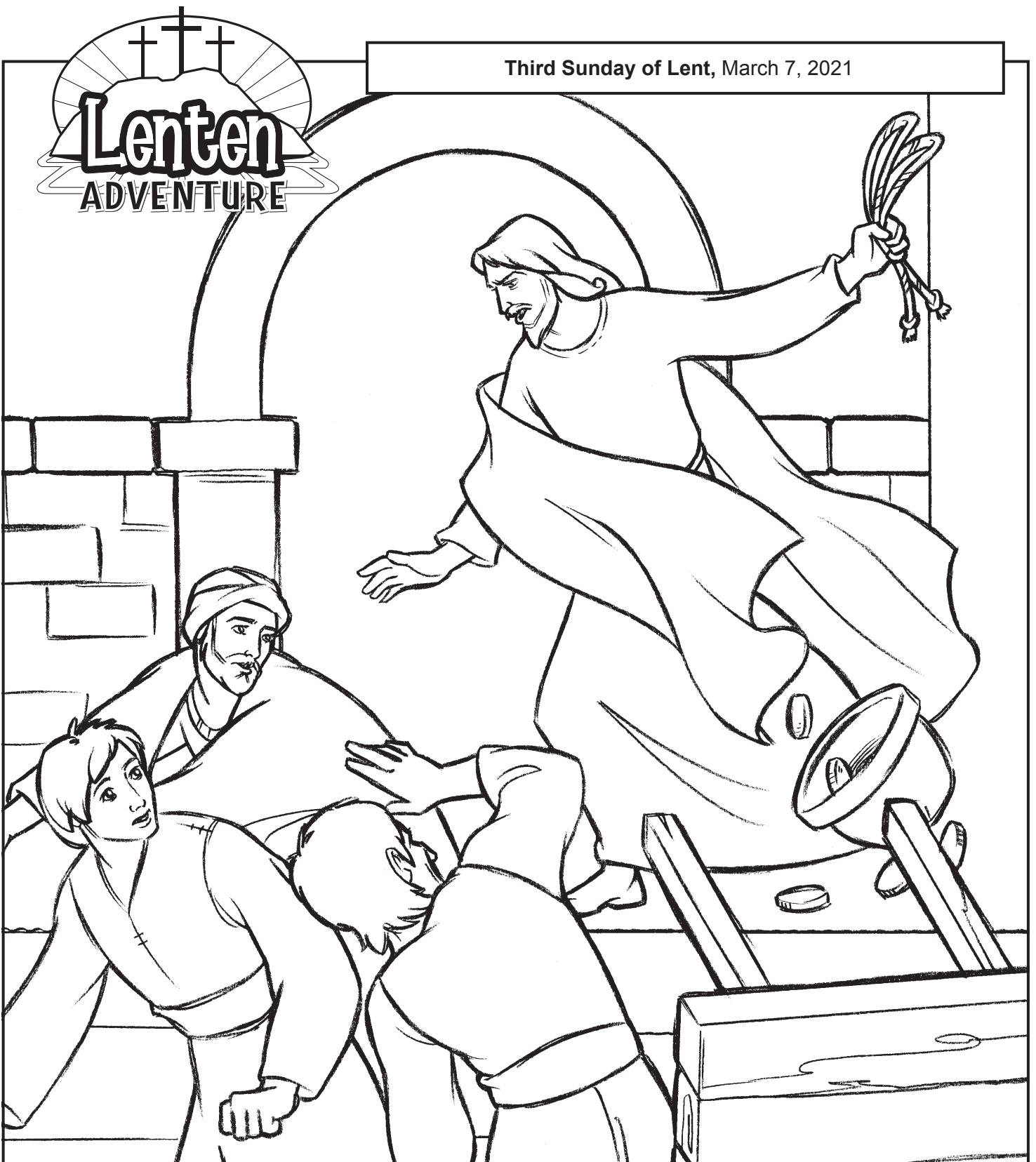


Third Sunday of Lent, March 7, 2021
