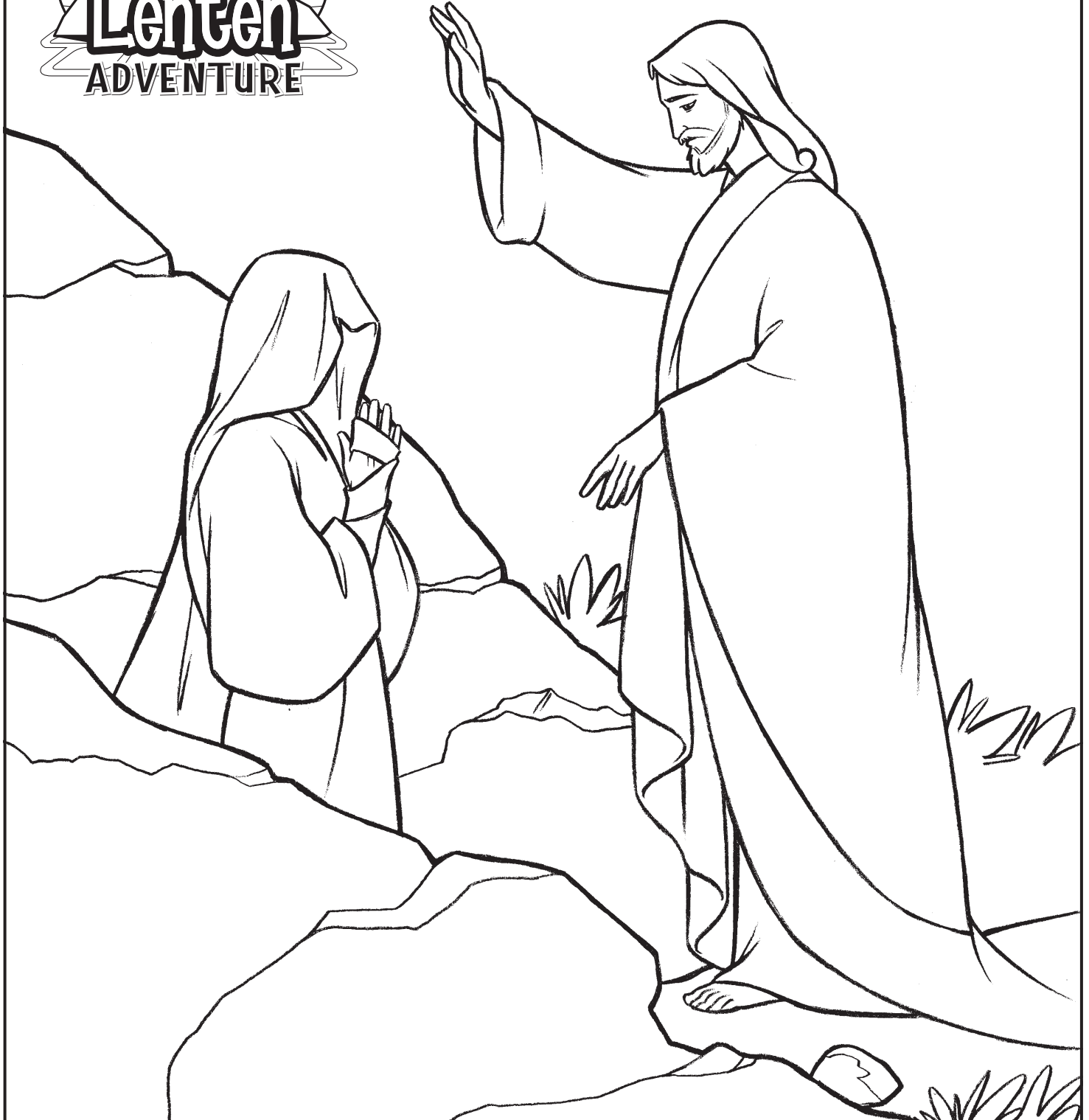

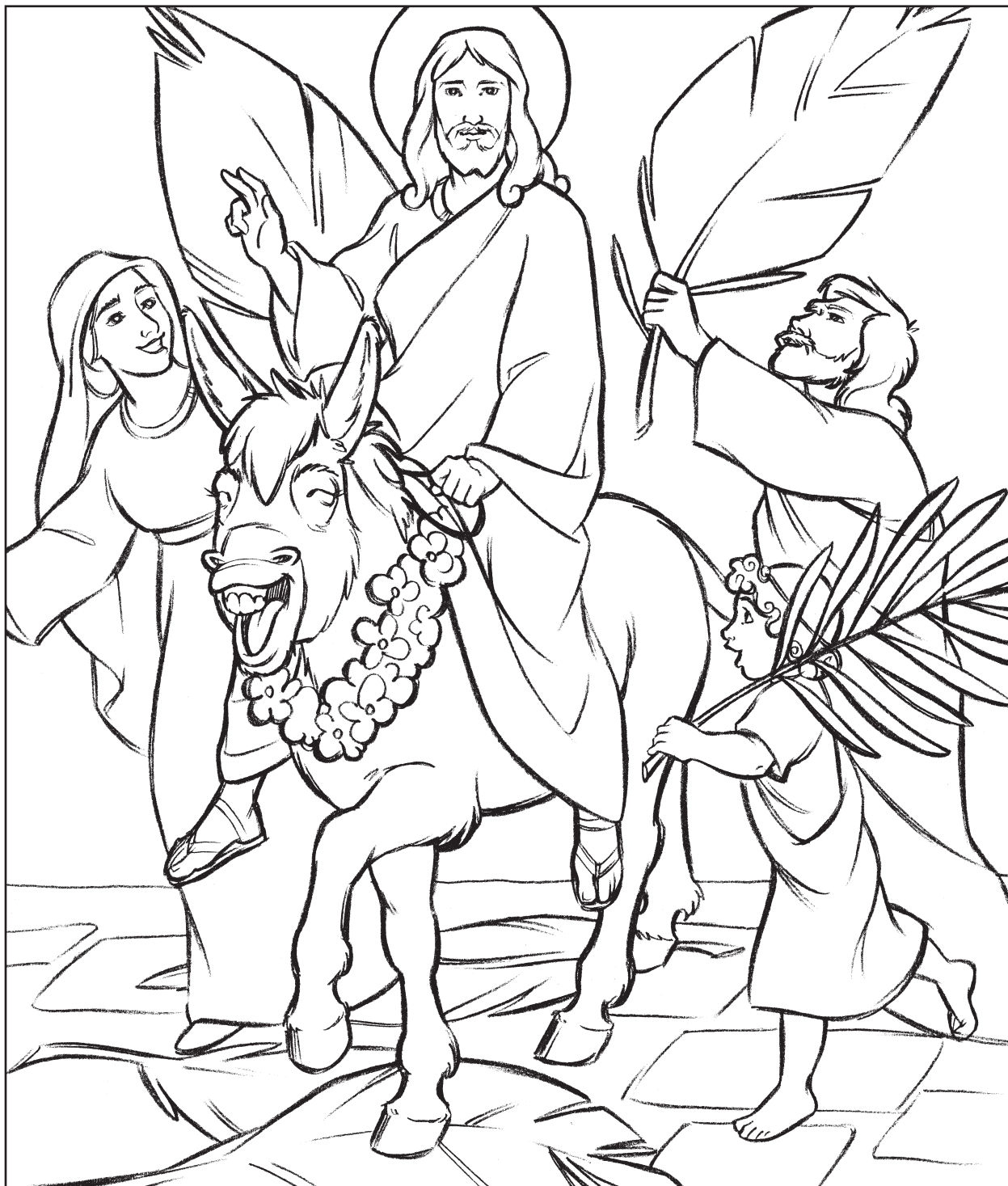


Fifth Sunday of Lent (Scrutinies), April 3, 2022

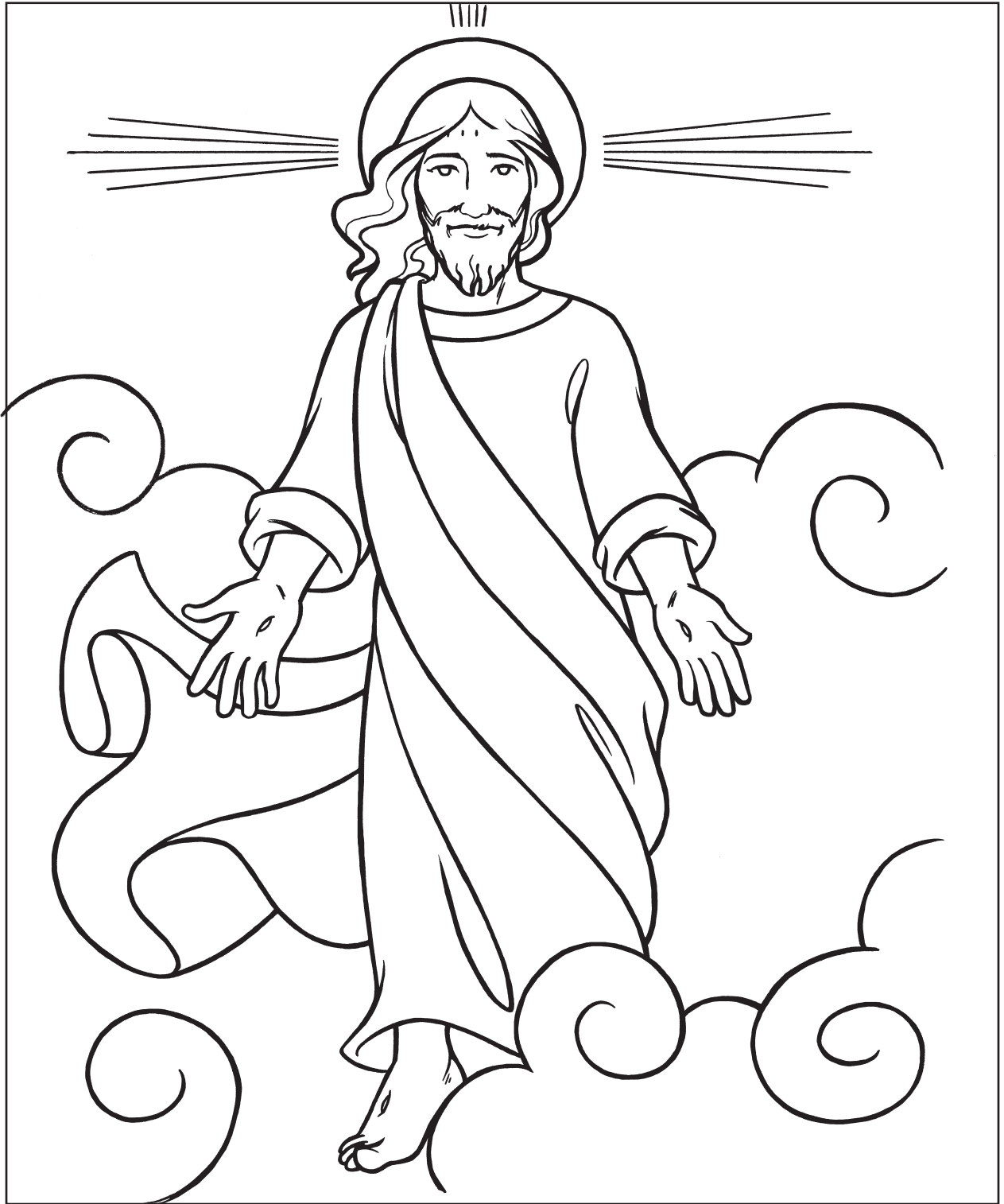

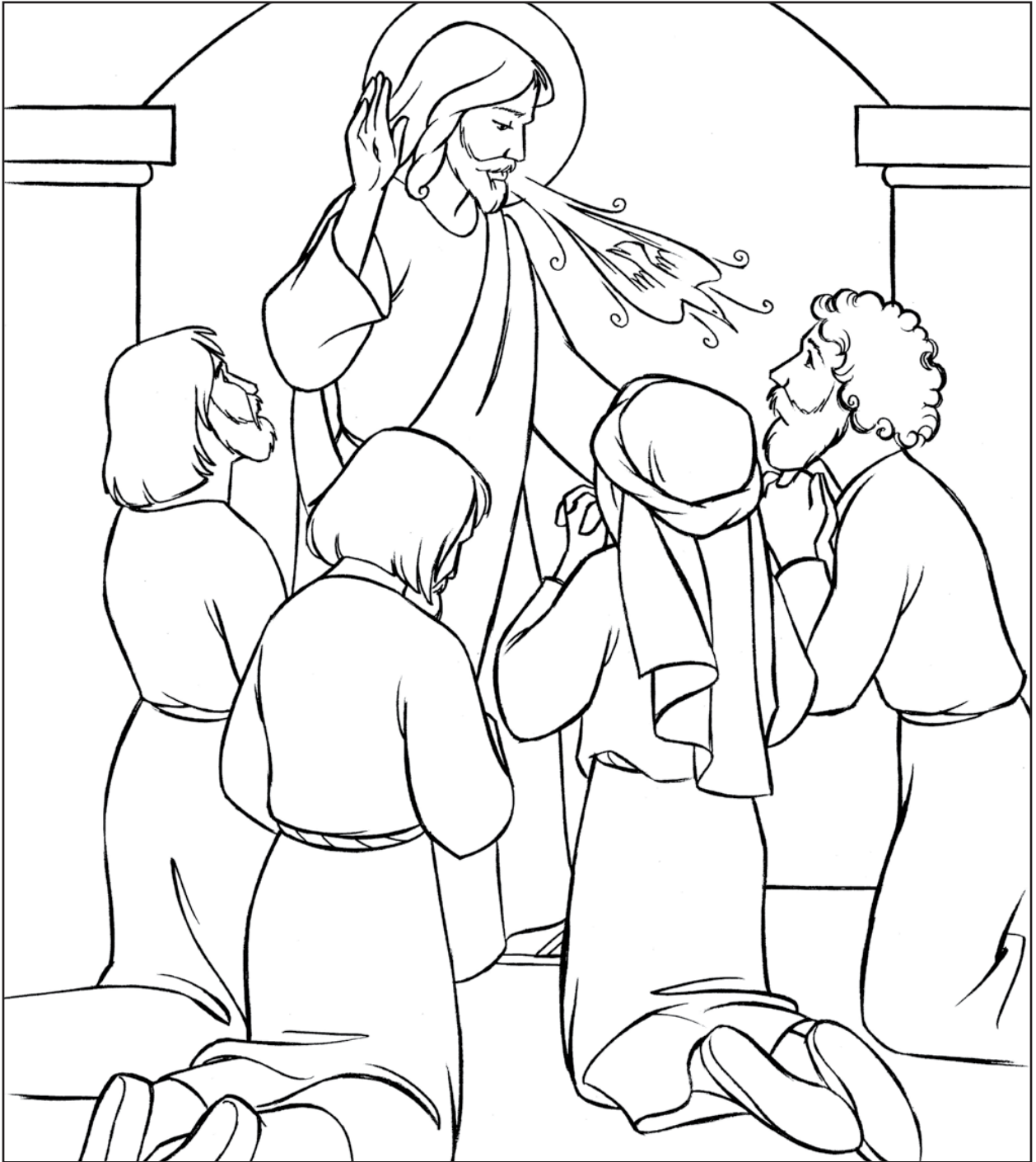
