


Hooray—we are two weeks closer to the birthday of Jesus!




Hooray—it's finally the Fourth (and last!) Sunday of Advent!



The angel Gabriel was sent from God to a town of Galilee called Nazareth, to a virgin betrothed to a man named Joseph, of the house of David, and the virgin's name was Mary. [The angel said], "Behold, you will conceive in your womb and bear a son, and you shall name Him Jesus. He will be great and will be called Son of the Most High, and the Lord God will give Him the throne of David His father, and He will rule over the house of Jacob forever, and of His kingdom there will be no end." (Luke 1:26-27, 31-33)



And when the time came for their purification according to the law of Moses, they brought Jesus up to Jerusalem to present Him to the Lord ... and to offer a sacrifice according to what is said in the law of the Lord, "a pair of turtledoves, or two young pigeons." (Luke 2:22-24)
