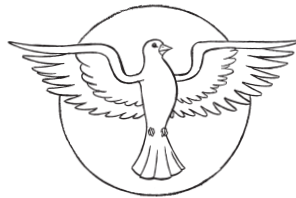


Third Sunday of Easter
