



In this week's 1st Reading, we heard that the prophet Elijah goes to a city called Zarephath. While in this city, he meets a widow and asks her for a cup of water and some bread. She tells Elijah that she only has a small amount of flour and oil left; after it is gone she and her son will die of hunger. Elijah responds that the once the widow bakes him a small cake, the LORD will not let her flour and oil run out. The widow followed Elijah's instructions and "...she and he and her household ate for many days. The jar of flour was not spent, neither did the jug of oil become empty, according to the word of the LORD that he spoke by Elijah." (1Kings 17:15-16)
